Thank you for your partnership as we navigate health protocols related to COVID-19. Teamwork during our Tuesday morning assembly provided opportunity for us to affirm and thank scholars for wearing their masks and doing their part daily. Teaming together we can ensure our goals of in-person instruction. To that end we need to be ever mindful that Orange County continues to be in the most restrictive "Purple" tier and cases are still on the rise. It is essential we exercise an abundance of caution as we enter the holiday and cold/flu season. Feelings of complacency and fatigue of the restrictions we've been living with since March could have a very negative impact on the Academy and our ability to maintain in-person instruction. We urge you to consider your Activ8 community before placing yourselves in a situation, party or grouping that may lead to a family exposure to COVID-19 during the approaching holiday season.

Additionally, please be mindful of after school or weekend activities that could threaten Activ8's on-campus operations. Considering how close knit our Academy community is, a positive COVID-19 case could result in not just a single person needing to quarantine, but depending on the rate of exposure, multiple classrooms and extending family members would have to adhere to a 14-day quarantine period as well.


